FAYETTE COUNTY COMMISSION BALLOT ISSUE TO CONTINUE ADDITIONAL LEVIES TO FUND SPECIFIC PUBLIC SERVICES (May 14, 2024)

Instructions: Voters who support one or more of the additional levies should make a selection before the words "For the (Levy Name) Levy" for Law Enforcement, Public Libraries and/or Fire Stations and Fire Protection Units and voters who oppose one or more of the additional levies should make a selection before the words "Against the (Levy Name) Levy" for Law Enforcement, Public Libraries and/or Fire Stations and Fire Protection Units. Voters may support or oppose all three levies or any combination of levies.

Should the County obtain additional funds from the State or Federal governments or any other source, it may use the funds in substitution of or in addition to the amount collected from the levy for any of the above-stated public services, including as justification to reduce the levy rates for the following fiscal year. Any unused levy funds from a fiscal year shall carry over to continue to fund the specific public service for the following fiscal year(s).

Per the Order entered by the County Commission on the 20th day of February 2024, a ballot issue to authorize an additional levy in the approximate annual amount of \$1,300,124.00 for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028 for the purpose of funding Law Enforcement salaries, benefits, equipment and facilities not covered by current revenue, provided the County Commission shall review each additional levy rate amount before the start of each fiscal year pursuant to West Virginia Code § 11-8-6g(a), and may, at its sole discretion, decrease any and all additional levy rate amounts for the upcoming fiscal year if it finds them unnecessary to fund these public services. Any decrease approved by the County Commission shall be in effect only for that fiscal year, after which the rate of any additional levy rate amounts decreased shall return to the original rate absent further action by the County Commission. Voters should note this levy cycle has been shortened to four years from the previous five-year cycle to coincide with the State budgeting process.

The additional rate levy rate to fund Law Enforcement salaries, benefits, equipment and facilities in cents per \$100 of assessed valuation shall be: on Class I property two and forty three-hundredths cents (2.43 cents/\$.0243); on Class II property four and eighty six-hundredths cents (4.86 cents/\$.0486); on Class III property nine and seventy two-hundredths cents (9.72 cents/\$.0972); and on Class IV property nine and seventy two-hundredths cents (9.72 cents/\$.0972).

County Commission on the 20th day of February 2024, a ballot issue to authorize an additional levy in the approximate annual amount of \$593,884.00 for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028 for the purpose of operating and maintaining Public Libraries, provided the County Commission shall review each additional levy rate amount before the start of each fiscal year pursuant to West Virginia Code § 11-8-6g(a), and may, at its sole discretion, decrease any and all additional levy rate amounts for the upcoming fiscal year if it finds them unnecessary to fund these public services. Any decrease approved by the County Commission shall be in effect only for that fiscal year, after which the rate of additional levy rate amounts decreased shall return to the original rate absent further action by the County Commission. Voters should note this levy cycle has been shortened to four years from the previous five-year cycle to coincide with the State budgeting process.

The additional levy rate to operate and maintain Public Libraries in cents per \$100 of assessed valuation shall be: on Class I property one and eleven-hundredths cents (1.11 cents/\$.0111); on Class II property two and twenty-two hundredths cents (2.22 cents/\$.0222); on Class III property four and forty-four hundredths cents (4.44 cents/\$.0444); and on Class IV property four and forty-four hundredths cents (4.44 cents/\$.0444).

Per the Order entered by the County Commission on the 20th day of February 2024, a ballot issue to authorize an additional levy in the approximate annual amount of \$1,615,792 for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028 for the purpose of erecting, maintaining, equipping and operating Fire Stations and Fire Prevention Units, provided the County Commission shall review each additional levy rate amount before the start of each fiscal year pursuant to West Virginia Code § 11-8-6g(a), and may, at its sole discretion, decrease any and all additional levy rate amounts for the upcoming fiscal year if it finds them unnecessary to fund these public services. Any decrease approved by the County Commission shall be in effect only for that fiscal year, after which the rate of additional levy rate amounts decreased shall return to the original rate absent further action by the County Commission. Voters should note this levy cycle has been shortened to four years from the previous five-year cycle to coincide with the State budgeting process.

The additional levy rate to erect, maintain, equip and operate Fire Stations and Fire Prevention Units in cents per \$100 of assessed valuation shall be: on Class I property three and sixty one-hundredths cents (3.61 cents/\$.0361); on Class II property seven and twenty two-hundredths cents (7.22 cents/\$.0722); on Class III property fourteen and forty four-hundredths cents (14.44 cents/\$.1444); and on Class IV property fourteen and forty four-hundredths cents (14.44 cents/\$.1444).
