Per the Order entered by the County Commission on the 20th day of February 2024, a ballot issue to authorize an additional levy in the approximate annual amount of \$593,884.00 for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028 for the purpose of operating and maintaining Public Libraries, provided the County Commission shall review each additional levy rate amount before the start of each fiscal year pursuant to West Virginia Code § 11-8-6g(a), and may, at its sole discretion, decrease any and all additional levy rate amounts for the upcoming fiscal year if it finds them unnecessary to fund these public services. Any decrease approved by the County Commission shall be in effect only for that fiscal year, after which the rate of additional levy rate amounts decreased shall return to the original rate absent further action by the County Commission. Voters should note this levy cycle has been shortened to four years from the previous five-year cycle to coincide with the State budgeting process.
